Emerald NDRRA Roadwork's – Package 7

Value: \$2m – \$2.5m

Completed June 2016

Widening and repairing of roads affected by inland floods. This involved cross drainage of roads, construction of new roads and resurfacing roads in remote areas.

Hursley Road Sub-Division – Stage 3-5

Value: \$3m – \$3.5m

Completed May 2016

Extension to a current sub-division incorporating roads, drainage (both above and sub-surface) and kilometres of retaining walls with various heights due to the sloping terrain.

Pittsworth Water Reclamation

Value: \$750k – \$1m

Completed March 2016

Removal of unused sewer tanks and systems and earthworks for the installation of Greenfield Sewer system. Included preparation of the sites, installation of tanks and associated pipeworks (including gravity fed and pump systems allowing for a complete system) and the installation of a belt press within a custom built industrial shed.

Wyreema Sewer and Water

Value: \$6m – \$6.5m

Completed March 2016

Upgrade of a sewer treatment plant, including work on several kilometres of pipework crossing through residential and rural infrastructure. Collaborative work with utilities on rail crossing points and creek crossings in the pipeline stages.

O-I Brisbane Roof Replacement

Completed February 2016

Installation of new structural roofing and roofing iron. Included removal and containment of asbestos products within the roof and ceiling, whilst working above an operating manufacturing facility in a restricted access dwelling.

Glenridge Boundary Sub-Division

Completed November 2015

Transforming two rural paddocks into a residential sub-division, linking up with existing residential areas. This project was conducted on the reverse slope of the Greenfields area with undulating terrain facilitating the sub-division for residential occupancies.

Ballina Water Mains Replacement

Completed October 2015

Replacement of storm water and sewer lines in the industrial area of Ballina. This incorporated horizontal drilling and trenching for pipeworks as well as bulk earthworks.
